# Summary History of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church

Using the 1950's the idea surfaced to consider the formation of a new Lutheran church on the west side. Several factors were instrumental in this initiative but two stand out. West Decorah was developing with many new residents and at that time there was no Luther student congregation. Luther students typically trekked the mile from campus, across the Upper Iowa River, and up the hill to First Lutheran Church.

In response to these factors, a site for the new church was explored. A parcel of land was purchased for \$25,560 on November 7, 1957, on property which had formerly been a sheep pasture. Committees were organized and Sovik & Associates of Northfield, MN were engaged as architects. The first unit of the building, costing \$46,877, was constructed and the church formally organized as Good Shepherd Lutheran Church on November 24, 1958.

The first pastor at Good Shepherd was Rev. Palmer Russeth (served 1958-1965), who walked door to door in west Decorah, inviting people to take part in the new west side Lutheran Church. He was very successful in establishing Good Shepherd as a neighborhood church. The church as it was built at the time was comprised of the present fellowship hall as the sanctuary, and the hallway flanked by two classrooms was the "west wing", used for coffee, fellowship, small worship groups and education.

The second pastor was Rev. R. David Berg (served 1965-1974), whose focus was to cement the relationship of this church toward Luther College. Members of the time remember that Pastor Berg was on campus nearly daily having coffee with Luther faculty, encouraging participation in Good Shepherd as a place for progressive and independent thinkers.

Rev. Paul Hasvold (served 1974-1998) led in establishing Good Shepherd as a church of social action. Under his leadership Good Shepherd was a center for resettling Southeast Asians following the Vietnam War and alone sponsored over 300 Vietnamese, Cambodian and Hmong people to settle in Decorah. The English as a Second Language school for refugees in the area was located at Good Shepherd and the Southeast Asian Resettlement Agency was founded and administered here. Pastor Hasvold also reached out to persons with disabilities, and was state president of the Association for Retarded Citizens. He led in creating the addition of the present sanctuary, offices, sacristy, nursery, and classrooms in 1988.

Pastor Joan Mau (served 1999-2014) was known for her intellect, good preaching and counseling. Under her leadership, the congregation especially reached out to LGBTQ persons becoming a Reconciling in Christ (RIC) congregation in 2007.

Pastor Amy Larson, who began her ministry at Good Shepherd in 2015, is leading us to follow Jesus's imperative to feed the hungry and house the homeless. Good Shepherd at this time is active in supporting undocumented immigrants, and helping unaccompanied minors with legal and other problems. She is also expanding the church staff and programs and leading the initiative to study space needs for refurbishing the church building.

**July 2**, **1958** - Groundbreaking for Good Shepherd Lutheran Church

**September 7**, **1958** - Laying of cornerstone.

**September 14, 1958 -** First worship service; held outdoors; First Sunday School

**November 24**, **1958** - Good Shepherd formally established

**December 7, 1958 -** Pastor Palmer Russeth installed; last service September 1965 (deceased April 28, 2003)

December 14, 1958 - First Baptism

**May 17, 1959 -** First Affirmation of Baptism (Confirmation)

June 21, 1959 - Dedication of sanctuary and west wing. Sovik, Mathre & Associates, Architect, Northfield, MN; Stoltz Construction Co., New Hampton, IA **October 17, 1965 -** Pastor David R. Berg installed; last service June 16, 1974

July 1967-July 1999 - Quilt shows for Nordic Fest, first at Good Shepherd, later at the high school

1971 - Installation of first wooden pews

**August 18, 1974 -** Pastor Paul M. Hasvold installed; last service July 1, 1998 (deceased January 19, 2015)

**November 19, 1978 -** Dedication of Fuehrer organ (built 1968 in Bremen, Germany)

**November 20, 1988 -** Dedication of the present sanctuary, offices, fellowship hall and educational spaces. Architectural Design Group, Rochester; Finholt Construction, Decorah

**April 25, 1993 -** Property sold to Weston Noble for \$50,000; congregation voted to establish an endowment with the funds and then loan the principal of the endowment to pay off a portion of the mortgage January 23, 1994 - Good Shepherd Endowment Fund approved at the Annual Meeting

**August 28, 1994 -** Weavings by John Skare dedicated, located on front wall of sanctuary

**December 1994 -** Five new church pews built by Gunder Church Furniture placed in sanctuary

**October 1995 -** "Handicapped Access Lot" completed on west side of church building

**1998-1999 -** Interim Pastor Daniel David Wee (deceased November 11, 2011)

May 16, 1999-2014 - Pastor Joan A. Mau installed; last service September 1, 2014 (deceased May 24, 2015)

**July 2000 -** Krumkake sales for Nordic Fest replacing the quilt shows

**January 21**, **2007** - Certified as a Reconciling in Christ Congregation (RIC)

**November 23, 2008 -** Celebration of 50 years of worship, ministry, and community
